The concern that Christ showed for the bodily and spiritual welfare of those who are sick, or elderly is continued by the Church in its ministry to the homebound. This ministry is the common responsibility of all Christians, we should visit the sick and elderly, remember them in prayer, and celebrate the sacraments with them.

This involves visiting "shut-in" parishners who are unable to come to church. These parishners are in private homes. As a Homebound Extraordinary Ministers, you would only spend a few hours a month bringing the Lord's spiritual and healing comfort through your presence and that of the Eucharist.

Four requirements for participation:

Servant heart

Safe Environment Certification

Valid driver's license and vehicle

Complete Extraordinary Minister Training
